

Many comments received related to areas that were not consulted on – this feedback will inform the development of guidance and FAQs and the next Code update.







Timelines and next steps

1 October 2024:

The 2024 ABPI Code comes into operation

1 October 2024 to 31 December 2024: During this period, no material or activity will be regarded as being in breach of the Code if it fails to comply with its provisions only because of requirements which this edition of the Code newly introduces.

The new template for disclosure should be used to submit the 2024 data to Disclosure UK by **14.00 GMT Friday**, **28 March 2025**. Companies should:

- Familiarise themselves with the changes to the Code and associated materials
- Encourage relevant staff to view these webinars outlining the changes to the Code
- Update relevant policies and procedures and train staff
- Ensure that materials and activities that do not meet the requirements of the 2024 Code are withdrawn before 1 January 2025
